* <u>30% of Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in</u> Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 3^{rd} and 4^{th} Semester(2^{nd} Year).

✤ 40% Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 5th and 6thSemester(3rd Year).
