 - (a) It was a miracle of rare device,A sunny pleasure-dome with caves of ice!
 - (b) While here I stand, not only with the sense Of present pleasure, but with pleasing thoughts That in this moment there is life and food For future years.
 - (c) Heard melodies are sweet, but those unheard Are sweeter; therefore, ye soft pipes, play on;
 - (d) Make me thy lyre, even as the forest is: What if my leaves are falling like its own!
