(b) Perhaps you will see a glass-fly ride the evening breeze, Or hear a barn owl call from the silk cotton tree; 3. Answer any one in not more than 500 words: $15 \times 1 = 15$ (a) Comment on the significance of the train in Khuswant Singh's Train to Pakistan. (b) Show how in Khuswant Singh's Train to Pakistan the sleepy little border village of Mano Majra becomes a microcosm of the nation torn apart by the Partition. 4. Answer any one in not more than 500 words: $15 \times 1 = 15$ (a) How is madness used as a metaphor in 'Toba Tek Singh' by Manto?
 - (b) Comment on the woes of the Partition that Manik Bandyopadhyay's 'The Final Solution' brings to light.
