Programme Outcome

Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) Honours in Sociology

- Hiralal Mazumdar Memorial College for Women offers Sociology Honours and General at the Undergraduate Level under the aegis of the affiliating university- West Bengal State University (WBSU).
- Sociology Honours and General both are run as Three Years Degree Course, which is now divided into Six Semesters.
- A student taking Sociology Honours will be able to complete 14 Core Courses, 2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and 4 Discipline Specific Elective Courses (DSE) at the end of three years.
- A student taking Sociology General will be able to complete 4 Core Courses, 2 Discipline Specific Elective Courses or 2 Generic Elective Courses at the end of three years.
- The three years Bachelor of Arts Programme in Sociology will enable the students to think sociologically and not in common-sensical terms, develop critical understanding about various aspects of society and social life.
- Students will come to know about the development of the subject till date and will be able to know about the thinkers and theorists, who have contributed significantly to the discipline. The programme will also provide a cue to students about the various methods of studying society and its people.
- Moreover, at the end of this programme students will be able to grasp basic human values, which will help them in shaping their identities.
