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**FACILITIES OFFERED**

<b>ICT Enabled Classroom</b>	There are 10 ICT enabled classrooms that exhilarates the teaching-learning scenario. Students can perceive the text revealed through slides and images.
<b>Learning Management System</b>	To enable students to have access to lectures and materials at their convenience. Act as repositories of academic resources and updated study materials accessible through College website.
<b>Seminar Room</b>	There are 03 seminar rooms in the College. A close knit networking of the parallel communicative system is needed for the growth of knowledge of the students and enhancement of their processes. The seminar room as also used for students seminar and inter-college activities and so on.
<b>Laboratories</b>	Well-equipped and maintained by the respective departments. In addition to this, a Tissue Culture Lab has been primarily set up for research facility.
<b>Instrumentation Room</b>	Maintained by the Science Coordinators and is meant for shared use by all the science departments as well as supporting research activities.
<b>Library</b>	Automated central library holds more than 19000 books. E-resources are subscribed through NLIST consortium. In addition to this, there are 17 Seminar Libraries maintained by various departments.
<b>Workstation</b>	Maintained by the Computer Science Department, is a shared workspace for departments accessing computers.
<b>Career Counselling &amp; Placement Cell</b>	Act as a forum to find placement for students; training is imparted to willing candidates. Career Fair is regularly organised to inform the students about avenues and opportunities to achieve proper placement.
<b>Career Oriented Courses</b>	31 certificate and add on courses are run by the College to empower the students with additional skills and knowledge relevant to their field of study in order to compete in the outer world.
<b>Incubation Centre</b>	Impart training to students to enable them to have their own start-ups.
<b>WiFi Campus</b>	Free Wi-Fi facility for students and staff.
<b>Students' Health Home</b>	Medical facilities for all round development – physical, mental and spiritual as a needed aspect in this modern scenario of fast life and intense pressure.

<b>College Health Unit</b>	Run with the help of an experienced medical practitioner, available two days in a week.
<b>Sick Room</b>	Located at the ground floor of BLOCK-C is meant for any student feeling unwell while attending classes within the campus.
<b>Gymnasium</b>	There are 2 sports room with gym equipment and yoga amenities.
<b>Yoga and meditation</b>	Yoga, the first initiative on the part of an affiliating College under West Bengal State University, heals the mind and helps the students in concentration and keeps up with the studies and their life but also provide them inner strength and emancipation. For this reason the College offers Yoga classes to all students under an able supervisor
<b>Health and Diet Centre</b>	Run by Food and Nutrition Department, which provides nutritional advices to all stakeholders.
<b>Psychological Counselling Cell</b>	Run by Psychology Department to guide students to deal with crisis, prevent depression and improve well-being.
<b>Common room</b>	Shared space for students to sit and talk, relax and spend their free time.
<b>NSS &amp; NCC</b>	An active NSS unit are engaged in various activities with an intense sense of social responsibility. A strong NCC wing is dedicated to the cause of the nation.
<b>Students' Aid and Concession</b>	Provides support to financially weak and economically disadvantaged students to complete their studies successfully.
<b>SC/ST/OBC/Minority Scholarship</b>	Scholarships are available to eligible students through Kanyashree Prakalpo, Swami Vivekananda Merit Cum Means Scholarship for Minorities, Aikyasree and others.
<b>SC &amp; ST Cell, Minority Cell, OBC Cell</b>	To cater to the needs of the respective communities of the students.
<b>College Digital Notification</b>	Students' notice are shared through official students' WhatsApp group and College website
<b>Distance Education</b>	Study Centre of Netaji Subhas Open University (NSOU) and proposed centre of Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) within the College campus give students the opportunity to pursue post-graduate course of study.
<b>History Museum</b>	To educate and attract students to the rich culture and heritage of our nation.
<b>Excursion / Field Study</b>	Short trips are organised by various departments for their students with educational purpose like onsite industry visit, farm visit and so on.

<b>Canteen and Purified Water</b>	Subsidized canteen and space is available to sit and eat comfortably. Water purifiers are installed at all floors.
<b>Vending Machine</b>	Self-service vending machines used for dispensing sanitary napkins are installed in all the girls' toilet.
<b>Grievance Redressal Cell</b>	Addresses all types of grievances, complaint's within the campus received from students, guardians and staff through Suggestion Box.
<b>Cell Against Sexual Harassment</b>	The Cell attends to complaints received on the grounds of sexual harassment at workplace with confidentiality, dignity and respect to ensure a safe working environment for all.
<b>Anti-Ragging Cell</b>	Ensures that campus is free from any sort of ragging. The college campus is under CCTV surveillance to monitor and prevent any such activity.
<b>Students' &amp; Guardian Feedback</b>	Valuable feedback are collected regularly and analysed to identify the areas which requires attention and improvement.
